28.12.2023 – Thursday, (about 3 h, min. 10 persons)

1. Nicolaus Copernicus & Krakow

Route: Kopernika str., Jagiellonian University, church of St. Anna, Polish Academy of Arts and Sciences

Meeting at 9, Galaxy hotel, tram ride to the Rondo Mogilskie stop. We will see Copernicus's place of study and several of his monuments. We will learn about the secrets of astronomical calculations, about the history of publications of the work "On the Revolutions of Heavenly Bodies", why his face appears on coins and banknotes. We will meet a Renaissance man on the 550th anniversary of his birth.

30.12.2023 – Saturday, (about 3 h, max. 25 persons)

3. Ghetto in Krakow - history

Route: Bohaterow Getta sq., Pharmacy Under the Eagle, str.: Lwowska, Jozefinska, Limanowskiego

Meeting at 9, Galaxy hotel, walking tour. We will walk through the streets of the Krakow ghetto, established on March 3, 1941; liquidated 80 years ago in March. We will see important places, gates leading to the ghetto, a fragment of the walls, and a museum in Tadeusz Pankiewicz's pharmacy, which was open during the existence of the ghetto. From the windows, the pharmacist could see the crimes committed by the occupant against the Jewish population

Kraków-wow



Krakow is one of the most beautiful cities in Europe, attracting millions of tourists from all over the world every year. The **Kraków-wow** project is a virtual journey through the Polish capital of kings, entered in 1978 on the first UNESCO World Heritage List. Google Arts & Culture, in cooperation with 13 cultural institutions in Krakow, makes a new online collection available. The collection includes over 50 exhibitions and over 2,000 exhibits. Thanks to the highest technology, we will look closely at the smallest details of the exhibits. 29.12.2023 – Friday, (about 3 h, min. 10 persons)

2. Jan Matejko in Krakow

Route: Matejko sq., Academy of Fine Arts, Slowacki Theatre, Floriańska str., Matejko's House, M. Square

Meeting at 9, Galaxy hotel, take a tram to the Stary Kleparz stop. The participants of the trip will follow the route that the Master walked every day, going from his apartment to the studio at the Academy, and will see the interiors of the oldest Bio-graphical Museum in Poland. They will find out why Jan Matejko is not buried in the Skalka crypt.

03.01.2024 – Wednesday, (about 3 h, min. 10 persons)

4. Krakow Economic Salon of PNB

Route: Szpitalna str., Basztowa str.

Meeting at 9, Galaxy hotel, take a tram to the Slowacki Theater stop. We will see two historic buildings of Krakow's banks. We will visit the Krakow Economic Salon, an educational facility of the National Bank of Poland. Visiting the exhibition, we will learn about the history of money in Poland. We will see interesting editions of commemorative coins, we will try to pick up a real gold bar. 2024 marks the 100th anniversary of establishing the zloty as the Polish national currency.
